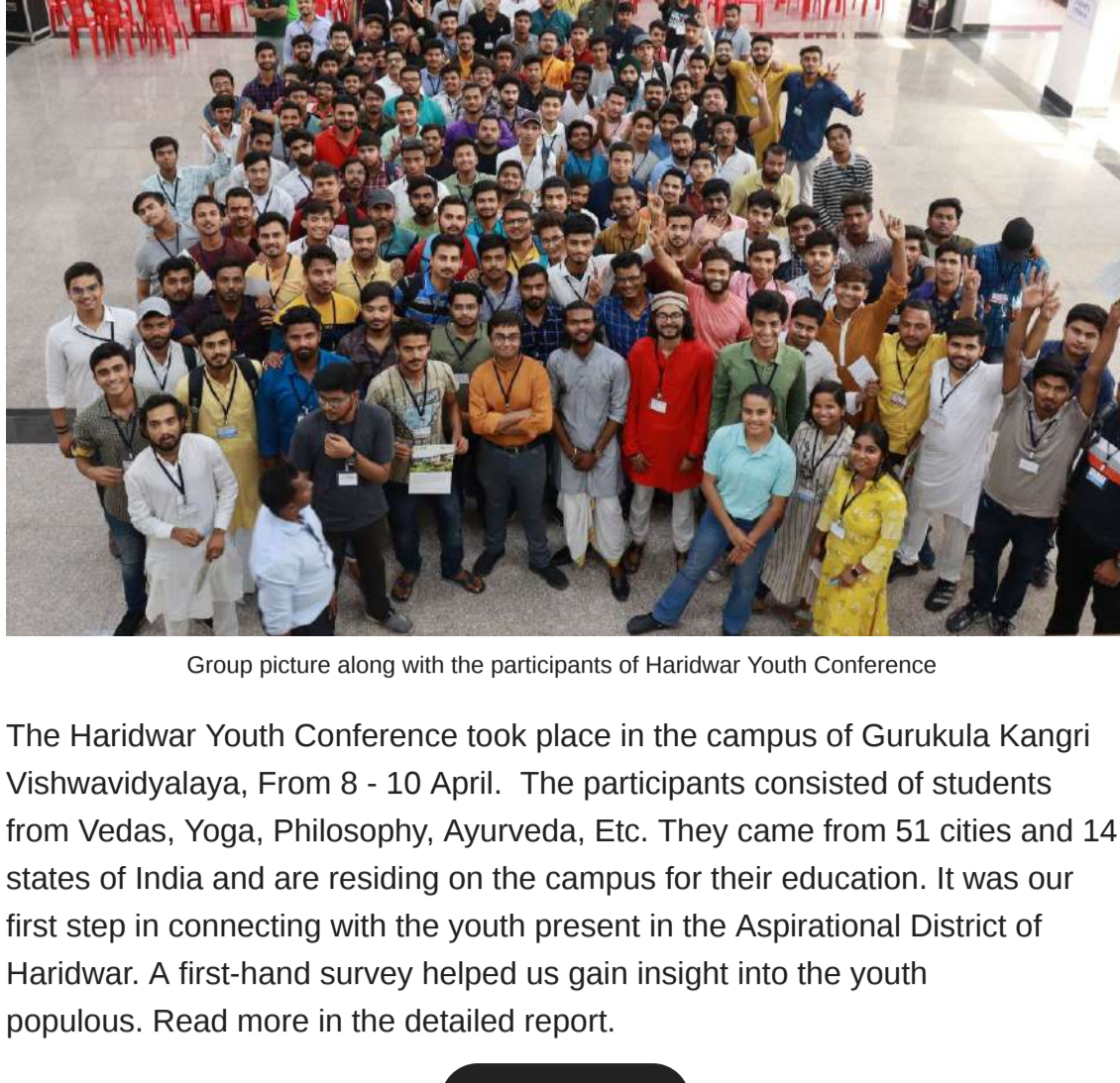


Haridwar Youth Conference

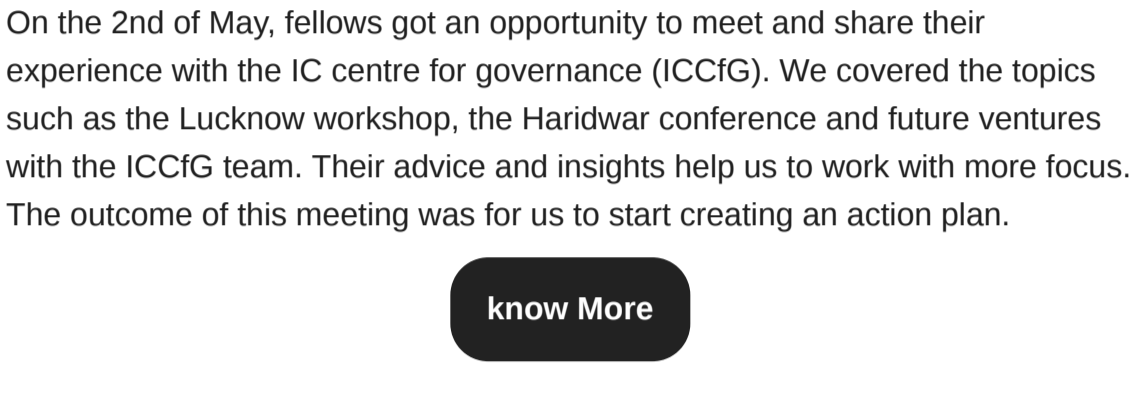
Meeting Mentors

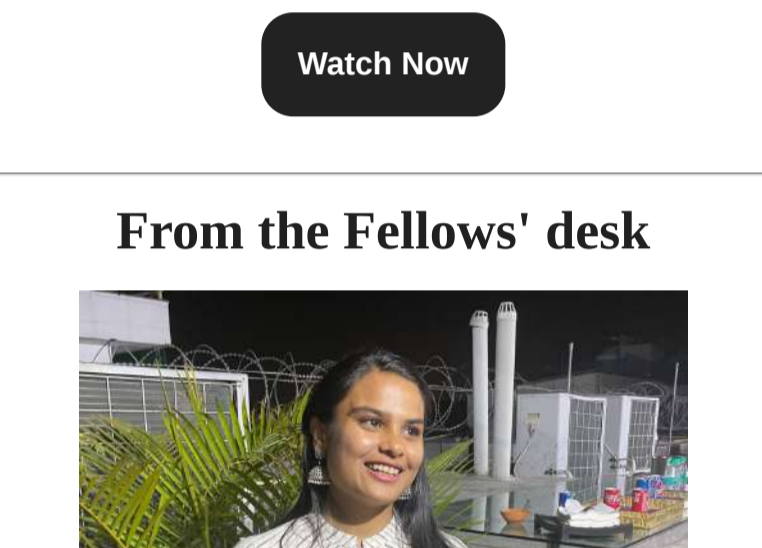
ICCFG Meeting

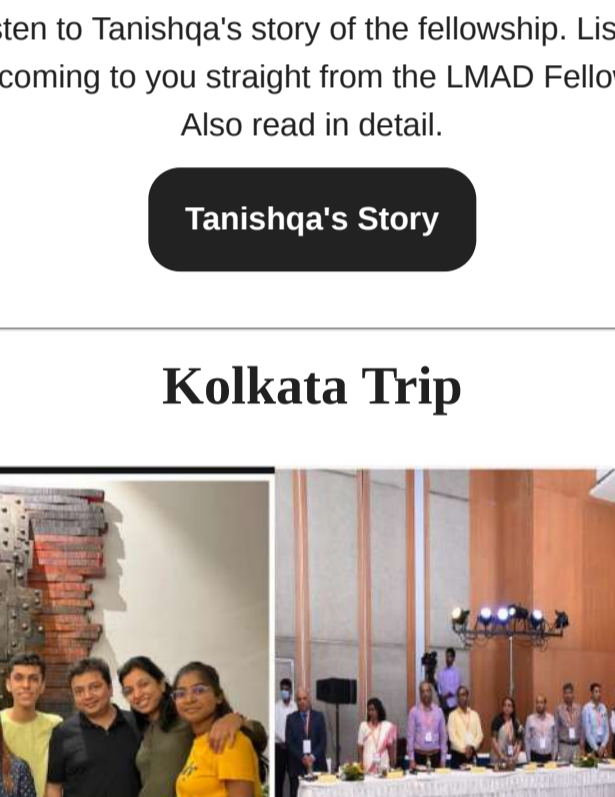

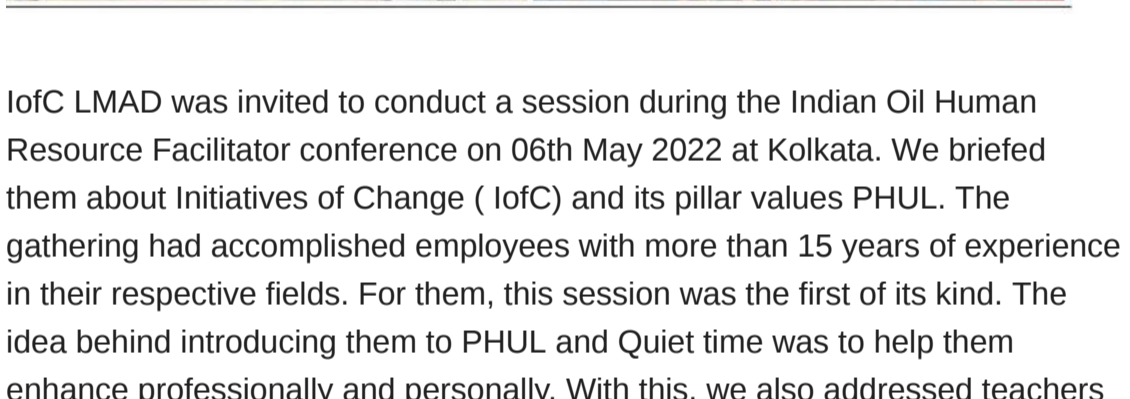

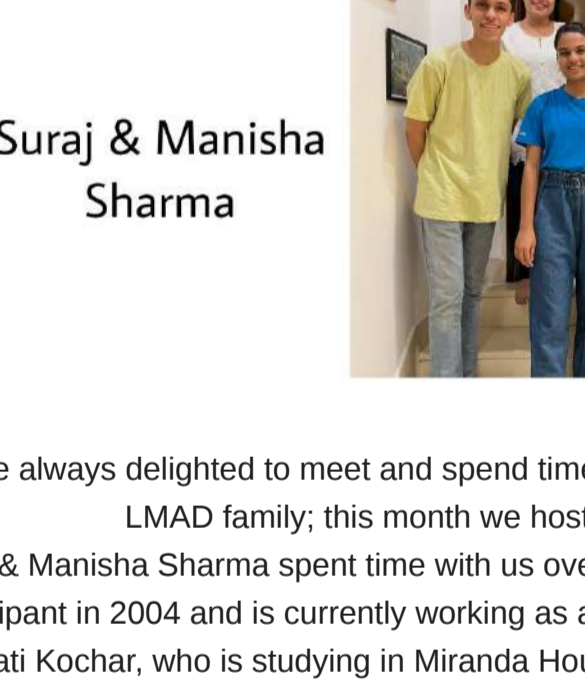

Kolkata Trip



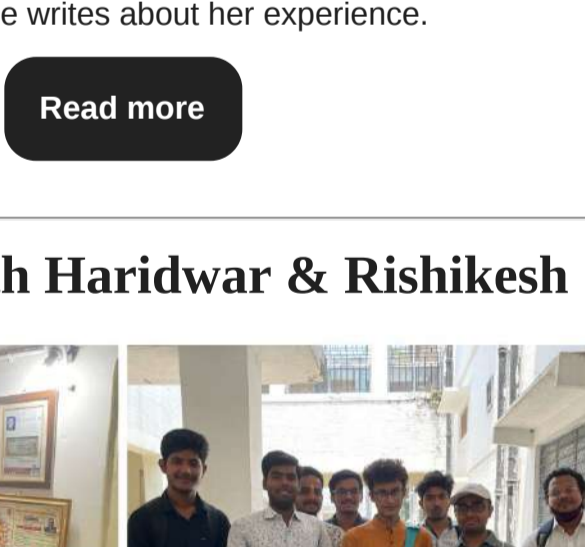

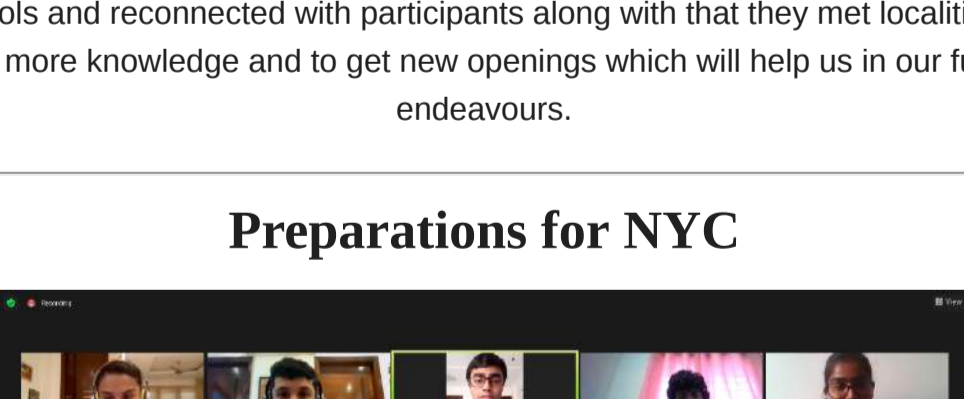
Suraj & Manisha Sharma

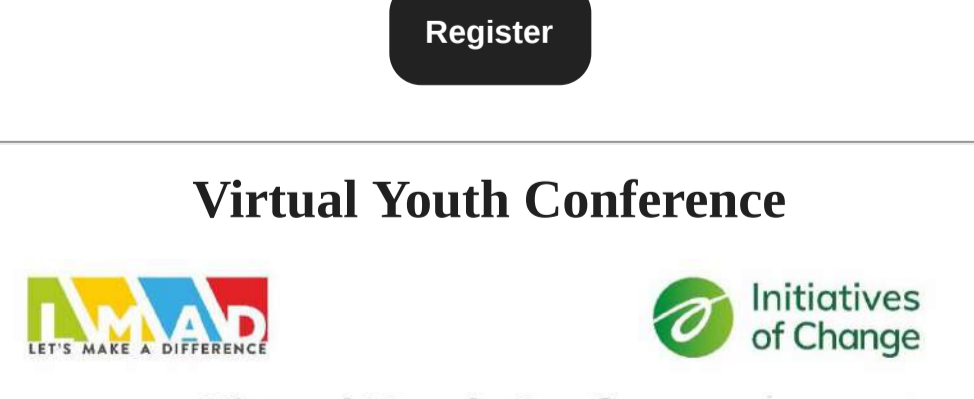

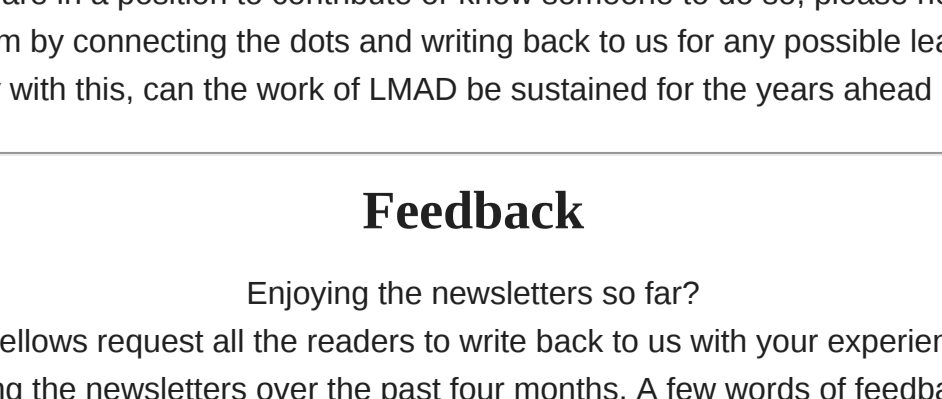
