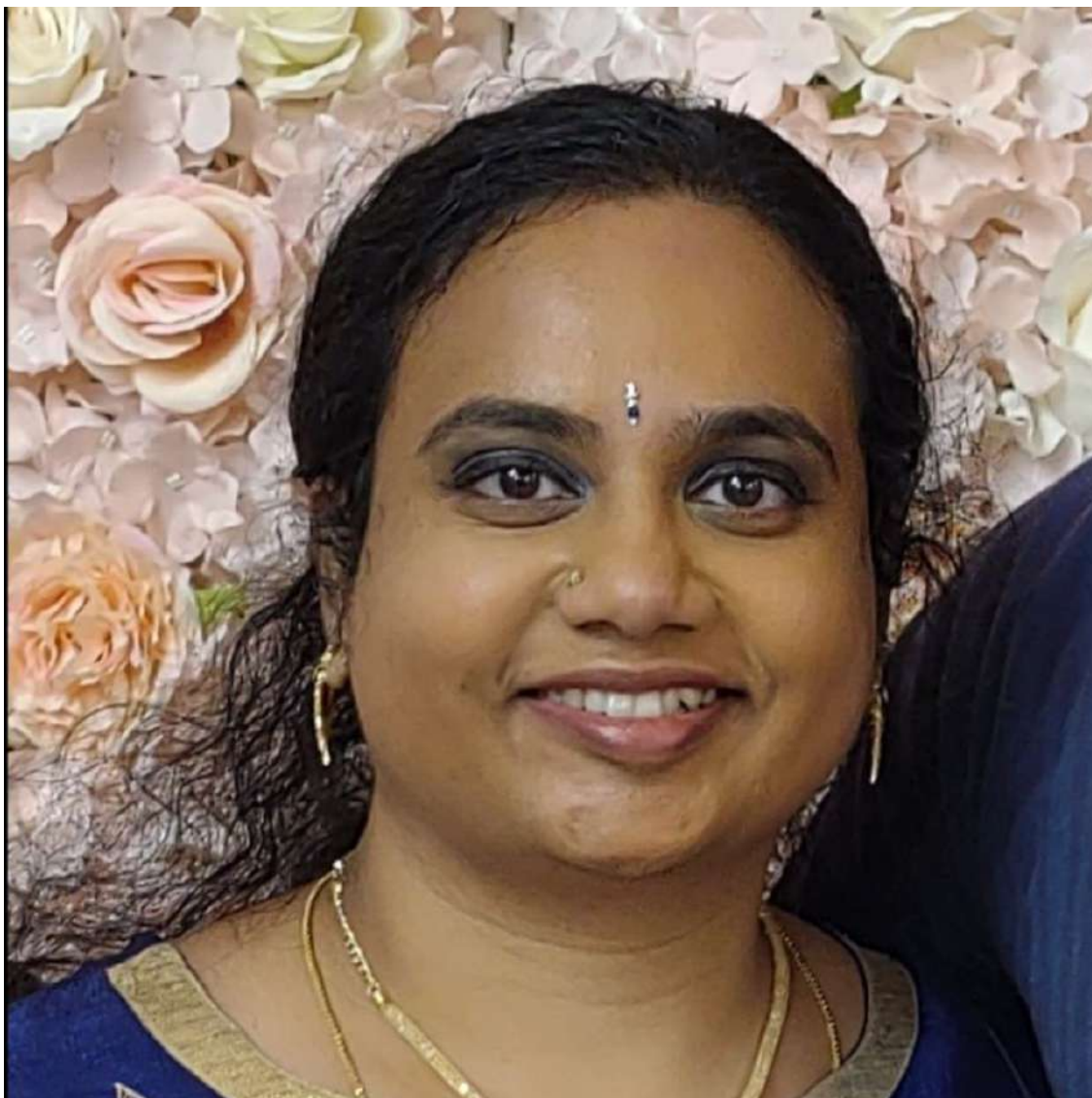
Yash's trip to Bhanpura

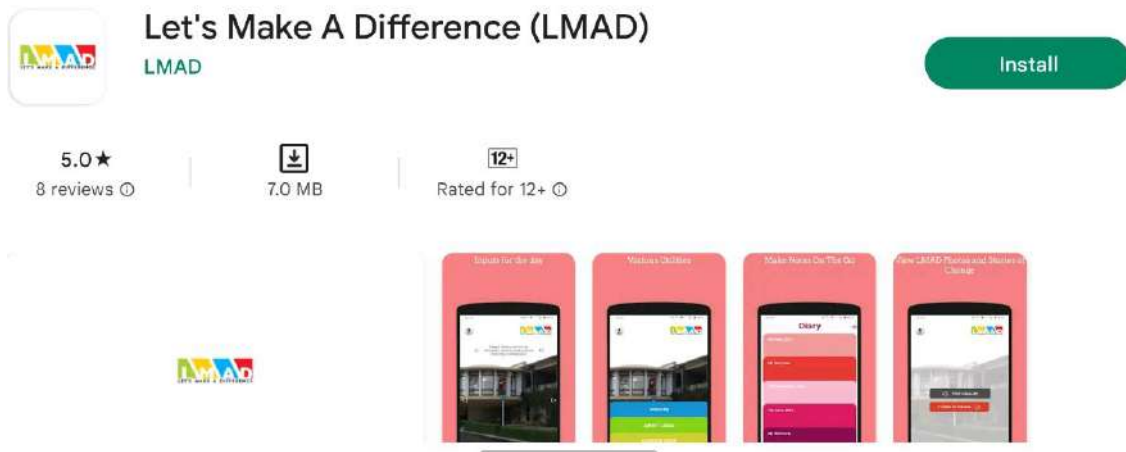
